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
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


Short history




- Quality of education an important discussion topic since mid 90's.
- (Constant) changes of the system of education, second major change of VET system since 2001.
- Pilot projects since year 2000 (system level and VET providers level).

From quality toward quality assurance



- Accreditation of provider, educational program, teachers and trainers,
- ... legislation in the field of provision of VET, ...
- ... development of VET providers and professional development of teachers and trainers, ...
- ... methodology of quality assurance.

Quality assurance since 2006




- Act of VET in 2006 – system level indicators, obligations for VET providers
- Act of Education in 2008 – self evaluation of schools
- 2009 – EQAVET Recommendation, Quality assurance national reference point (SIQA-VET)

System level




- Supporting QA systems at VET providers (law, legislation, projects, experts support)
- Council of experts for VET designated 7 system level quality indicators
- Institute for VET developing methodology for collecting and analysing data - fourth year – first three indicators

System level quality indicators for VET part 1



1. The percentage of training providers applying internal quality assurance systems defined by law (quality assurance);
2. the percentage of teachers and trainers with teaching qualifications (input);
3. the percentage of teachers and trainers participating in further education and training, the amount and share of funds invested by providers in their educational and training programmes (input);

System level quality indicators for VET part 2



4. the percentage of students who successfully complete their programme on schedule; (output)
5. the percentage of learners who succeed in final exams; (output)
6. destination of VET learners in six and twelve months after completion of training; (effect)
7. the percentage of programs developed in response to employers. (coop. with stakeholders)

VET providers level



- Commission for quality assurance – teachers and trainers, student, parents, employers;
- Self evaluation once a year;
- Quality assurance report once a year published on internet;
- Recommendation for self evaluation: Quality cycle (PDCA), areas, indicators, basic standard
